Strategy Description

Lazard Global Equity Select is a global, unconstrained strategy designed to leverage Lazard's best ideas. The strategy seeks to generate strong relative returns over a long-term time horizon by investing in companies with strong and/or improving financial productivity (e.g., return on equity, free cash flow, return on assets, cash flow return on investment) at attractive valuations. Global Equity Select typically invests in 60-80 companies from both developed and emerging countries.

Composite Description

The composite returns represent the total returns of all fully discretionary portfolios with a Global Equity Select investment mandate. Lazard Global Equity Select seeks to generate strong relative returns over a long-term time horizon by investing in companies with strong and/or improving financial productivity at attractive valuations. This strategy typically invests in securities from both developed and emerging countries, with market capitalizations typically greater than \$2 billion.

Calculation of Performance Returns

The composite inclusion criteria include accounts that have the ability to purchase issuers' ordinary shares. These accounts may also invest in US denominated equity securities of US and non-US companies. Lazard's Global Equity Select Composite includes all dedicated Global Equity Select portfolios and the Global Equity Select segment of other Lazard balanced accounts. Each account's carve-out segment has its own actual separate cash accounting. For the calendar year ends, between 2006 and 2010, the following are the respective carve-out percentages of the composite, 0.0%, 0.0%, 0.0%, 100.0%, and 100.0%. Carve-out net of fee performance has been calculated using the standard fee schedule for this strategy. Policies for valuing investments, calculating performance, and preparing GIPS reports are available upon request. The composite and benchmark returns are reported net of foreign withholding taxes on dividends, interest and capital gains. The composite returns presented represent past performance and is not a reliable indicator of future results, which may vary. Lazard's Global Equity Select product invests in a relatively small number of securities. Should any individual security held in this portfolio decline in value or underperform relative to the market, it may have a greater impact on the account's performance than if the account held a larger number of securities. Fee Schedule

Lazard's standard fee schedule for Global Equity Select accounts is 0.75% on the first \$25 million of assets, 0.50% on the next \$50 million of assets, 0.45% on the next \$50 million of assets and 0.40% on the balance. (This fee schedule may be presented in non-U.S. local currency based on prevailing exchange rates.) Composite net-of-fees returns are calculated by reducing monthly composite returns by the 12th root of the stated strategy fee's highest tier.

Benchmark Information

The MSCI ACW Index (ACWI) is a free float-adjusted market capitalization index that is designed to measure equity market performance in the global developed and emerging markets. The Index is compiled by MSCI Inc.

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On March 17, 2023, the Global Industry Classification Standards (the "Standards") were changed impacting several sectors and the classification of several securities. The vast majority of the firm's systems have been updated to reflect the revised Standards including client reporting and compliance guideline monitoring.
